



Neighbourhood Plan Referendum result

The Parish Council would like to express its gratitude for the excellent turnout on Referendum day and the strong mandate for the Neighbourhood Plan.

The votes cast were 587 (557 in favour 30 against). The turnout was over 40% with almost 95% in favour of adoption of the plan.

The comprehensive plan, highly praised by the Independent Examiner, is the culmination of many, many hours of diligent work and collaboration over the last few years.

As a statutory addition to the planning process, it will give a greater voice to local opinion.
