We will be working between the A259 and Wayfairing Down.

During the above times, access will be restricted to residents with traffic diverted via Wannock Road, A2270, A259 and vice versa.

Should you need access, please approach the closure point and speak to the site team. This is for access only and there will be no through route. There may be a short delay while we make it safe for you to pass, and your vehicle will be escorted by site marshals.

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.


How will you be affected?
