Title: Report Item 5: Council Noticeboards

Purpose of Report: To provide a note on the status of council-owned

noticeboards and obtain approval for maintenance

Recommendations: APPROVE the maintenance of the Noticeboards up the

budgeted provision

1. The Parish Council owns and maintains four physical noticeboards in three locations:-

NB1&2 Downlands Way precinct

NB3 adjacent to village hall car park
NB4 entrance to Windmill Lane/A259

- 2. All are of wooden construction. NB's 1&2 are fixed to a resident's property (by agreement), and NB3 and NB4 each stand independently on two uprights. Although still serviceable they are all in need of attention, primarily owing to damp ingress.
- 3. NB's 1, 2 and 3 are in areas of relative high footfall compared with NB4. The possible placing of a new NB at Birling Gap was considered but the NT reluctantly declined a request based on their current policies
- 4. There is a budget allowance of £500 in 2016/17 for NB maintenance but this is unlikely to be spent. This, coupled with the growing need for remedial action, led to the inclusion of £1,500 in the approved 2017/18 budget
- 5. It is proposed to:
 - a) remove NB4 at the entrance to Windmill Lane
 - b) get local builders/handi-man to report on the state of the remaining NB's and provide estimates for repair
 - c) instruct repairs/replacement up to the budgeted amount (or such other sums approved by the PCM)
 - d) schedule the work for around Q2 2017
 - e) report back to PCM when work is completed
 - f) nominate councillor Fuller as lead/contact
