Title: Report Item 6 – Village Safety Day

Purpose of Report: To consider if a safety day should be arranged for later

in 2017

Recommendations: To assess the support for a safety day and provide

feedback to the June PCM

The holding of Safety day has been suggested by some residents and by safety-related organisations.

A Safety Day was held in the village hall a couple of years ago. Although there was a number of stalls, attendance by the public was disappointing. It is assumed that the level of support reflected the marketing of the event rather than a lack of interest.

If another Safety Day was arranged the suggested timing would be around Sept/Oct 2017.

To test the level of support for such an event contact could first be made with:-

- a) residents via articles in the Parish Magazine, Rendezvous and website, and at the AVM
- b) *local organisations* eg East Dean Responders, Community Watch, Chapliancy
- c) non-local organisations eg Age Concern
- d) emergency services all

The PC is asked to agree in principle to arranging a Safety Day in Autumn 2017 and to assess the support for such an event from the groups listed above, and to review the matter further at the June PCM.
