Purpose of Report: To provide initial details of the proposed Grant Award

Scheme to be introduced from 2018/19

Recommendations: To approve the Award Scheme details

The October PCM agreed to the introduction of a Grant Fund for awards to be made to locally-based good causes effective from 2018/19.

Attached is a draft procedure and application form for the scheme. The form notes that the Council will not normally support commercial organisations, major charities, bodies considered to be self-funded or provided for by other authorities.

The timing included within the draft is that applicants submit their forms to the clerk during the period 1 March to 30 April each year. The PCM will consider these at their June meeting and the grants will be paid by end June. Depending on the number of applications received, a working group of (say) three Councillors and the clerk could be set up to review the forms and make recommendations to the June PCM.

A sum of £2,000 has been included for the Scheme in the draft 2018/19 Budget. The budget heading will include the Grants awarded via the application process, the PC's Charity of the Year, and any monies provided to the East Dean Responders under match-funding arrangements.



GRANT AWARDING POLICY

Introduction

The Parish Council welcomes and values the work of local voluntary groups and organisations. The Council has a policy for making grants to groups and organisations which contribute to the welfare of the community by improving or supporting facilities and/or activities. Applicants must be able to demonstrate a clear need for financial support.

Guidelines

An overall limit for the annual provision of grant aid will be determined as part of the Council's budget setting process and approved in January of each year.

Applicants will be able to apply for a grant between 1 March and 30 April each year.

Applicants must complete a grant application form which will include details of the need for the funds and the number of residents expected to benefit. The completed form will be returned to the Clerk of the Council by the end of April each year for decision at the following June Parish Council Meeting. Grants awarded will be paid by end June.

If the application is for a particular project or activity, any Grant awarded will generally not exceed 50% of the cost of the project or activity.

As a condition of receiving a grant, recipients will be required to acknowledge the Council's support in any publicity material.

The Council will not normally support commercial organisations, major charities, bodies considered to be self-funded or provided for by other authorities.

In exceptional circumstances, a grant may be awarded outside the grant timetable at the discretion of the Council. The Council reserves the right to offer an alternate amount to that originally requested or to refuse any grant application.
