Title: Report Item 7 – Business in Progress

Purpose: To provide an update on progress since the December meeting

Recommendations: To note the progress report

The following items are matters for report:

- Flooding of the Cuckmere – the parish council has asked for an update on progress in the transfer of the Seven Sisters Country Park to the SDNPA, and information on what stance the SDNPA would take in future regarding the management of the Cuckmere Estuary
- WDC Tourism website – parish information has been supplied, and a request made for the parish's walking maps to be available via the Healthy Wealden website.
- VE Day 75 – a letter giving information about the proposed event has been sent to village organisations, clubs and societies by the Lead Member, Cllr Wheatley, and it is hoped that there will be responses in support after the Christmas break
- Road maintenance using the precept – NALC is to be consulted on this matter of law and principle
- Budget 2021 to 22/23 – the Working Group met on 17 December and worked through the budget heads, sending a report to the Lead Member, Cllr Godden
- Interpretation boards – the need for planning permission in any of the chosen locations is to be investigated, along with the need for other permissions (e.g. Wealden District Council in the car park location)
- Downs View Lane verge – the council's regular mowing contractor has quoted £240 for including this in the contract in future.
- The Rude Mechanicals Theatre Company – the date of the 2020 performance is confirmed as Wednesday 10th June. A Licence is to be issued. The £50 donation from 2019 has been requested for the benefit of the JPK Project (which The Rudes are keen to support, as they already support this project)
- CIL Funding – the parish council has asked why no projects have received funding at this end of the Park
