Thanks for the message. Your email into the Safer Roads Partnership will trigger a triage and review of the area, and they may make suggestions on how to tackle the issues you have raised. Depending on that review, taskings are sometimes sent out to the Neighbourhood Policing Teams to undertake high visibility patrols / targeted activity / speed checks etc.

Other enforcement options include taskings into other departments who have the capability to undertake mobile speed testing etc.

Until that review is completed we will not know what is recommended, but hopefully that should give you some idea.

We do have issues with racers who use Gilbert's Drive and Birling Gap Road as a race track especially at weekends and nighttime. Eastbourne Borough Council have successfully introduced a PSPO from the Eastbourne / East Dean boundary of the A259 that goes anti-clockwise right around past Beachy Head to the boundary with Wealden BC near Birling Gap i.e. Warren Hill and Beachy Head Road up to the boundary of Wealden Borough Council.
